

Scenario	UPA Protocols
Students with Covid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quarantine at home for a full 10 Days regardless if the student is asymptomatic.
Close Contact (At School)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> UPA will identify close contacts who were within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes within 24 hours of someone that tested +. Close contacts will be given rapid tests to self-administer on campus and a close contact email is sent to families. Students that test negative may remain on campus. Those that test positive must isolate for 10 days regardless if the student is asymptomatic. If a student is experiencing COVID like symptoms especially loss of taste or smell and/or fever, the student must take a PCR or at home rapid test. The student may return to school after receiving a negative test result AND after symptoms subside.
Close Contact (Outside of School and Non Household Member)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The student can continue to attend school if fully vaccinated AND asymptomatic. If a student is experiencing COVID like symptoms especially loss of taste or smell and/or fever, the student must take a PCR or at home rapid test. The student may return to school after receiving a negative test result AND after symptoms subside. The front office will verify a negative test result prior to the student returning to class.
Close Contact (Household Member)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quarantine for 5 full days regardless of vaccination status. Student needs to take either a PCR or at home rapid test on day 5 and may return to school after receiving a negative test result. If a student is experiencing COVID like symptoms especially loss of taste or smell and/or fever, the student must take a PCR or at home rapid test. The student may return to school after receiving a negative test result AND after symptoms subside. The front office will verify a negative test result prior to the student returning to class.
